

MID-SOUTH FOLKLORE

The Division of English, Philosophy, and Languages of Arkansas State University announces the publication of Mid-South Folklore, a scholarly periodical devoted to the presentation of annotated folklore collectanea with adequate analysis to illuminate the material.

The philosophy underlying the publication of Mid-South Folklore is that a regional periodical can best contribute to general folklore scholarship by characterizing, as far as possible, the kind of folklore which exists or has existed in the region covered. Hence, Mid-South Folklore will deal with articles concerning Arkansas and its adjacent states. In content, the articles will concentrate on presenting the primary materials of folklore scholarship -- scientifically collected texts, relevant items from printed sources, descriptions of folklife products and processes, depictions of folklore performance events. This raw data, presented with as complete context information as possible, will be annotated using existing indexes and other relevant bibliography. Also, the material will be analyzed from whatever perspective the contributors and editor think will prove most fruitful. The forms of the contributions should follow those prescribed in the second edition of the MLA Style Sheet.
